"Tha name of the child is 'Today' – children [who are legally available for adoption] should be placed in permanent families as soon as possible," she said.

The participants immediately proceeded in a short activity, featuring awarding and games, after the run. Roman Matthew Feliciano is the 3rd placer; John Lloyed Villas, 2nd and the first to finish the run is Eddie Loresco.
