

Luzon Stronghold: 4 Resolutions Passed to Strengthen Inter-Regional Coordination and Support

BALER, AURORA – Luzon Cluster (NCR, CAR, I, II, III, IV-A, IV-B, and V) DSWD Regional Directors have passed four (4) resolutions that will strengthen the inter-regional coordination and support which was established through the DSWD Luzon Stronghold Resolution No. 001 Series of 2021.

The resolution are as follows: (1) Establishing Inter-Regional Operationability for Disaster Response and Early Recovery Through Synergy and Convergence; (2) A Resolution on Standardization of Systems and Process; (3) Inter-Regional Pilot Testing of the Virtual Disaster Response Operation Center; (4) Establishment of AICS Contactless Application and E-payment (ACAP) in Providing Social Services to Individuals and Families in Crisis at the Regional and Local Government Units; (5) Adoption and Deployment of Unified System of Project power and power Grid.
