



1. Brief Background on Who and Where the Poor Households Are




Figure 1 shows the magnitude of poor households within the twenty-two (22) municipalities within the province of Pampanga. Out of 133,148 households, 55,328 were identified as poor. ³ The city of Angeles listed to have the highest number of poor households comprising to 4,738 or 8.56% of the total number of poor households. It is followed by Candaba with 4,571 or 8.26% and Lubao with 4,193 or 7.58%. ⁴



Figure 2 shows the income distribution of poor households within the province of Pampanga. All the 55,328 identified poor households within this province were found to earn below the annual per capita poverty threshold of PHP17, 243 (the needed income for a family of six members to be out of poverty) ^{5.} This means that a poor household with six (6) members earns PHP47.27per day. There were no poor household that were found to have an income which is above or equal to the average annual per capita income.

2. Who and where the poor households are in terms of household composition?

The average household size among identified poor households is six (6) members. The total number of poor individuals within the province of Pampanga is 327,222. Of these, 157,760 are women whereas 169,462 are men. It can also be regarded that children comprises a large portion of the population of poor individuals with 52.97% percentage share.

The combined sector of women and children constituted almost half of the individual population of the poor. The sector of the children constituted the largest part of the total number of poor individuals with 52.97% percentage share followed by the women sector which comprised the 47.92% of the total population of the poor individuals. The levels of different sectors are presented as follows:

a. Children's Sector





Figure 3 shows the number of children within this province whose ages were below 18 .The municipality of Angeles, Arayat and Candaba were recorded to have the largest number of children in poor households. The percentage shares of poor children in these municipalities were 55.20%, 54.47% and 51.09% respectively.

Out of 144,251 children whose ages are within the interval 3 to 18 years, there were 37.53% or 54,142 who were not attending school. The city of Angeles were recorded to have the largest number of poor children who are not attending school with 5,694 or 45.23%, followed by the municipality of Arayat with 4,641 or 40.87% and municipality of Candaba with 4,020 or 36.24%. In terms of educational attainment of poor children, 40.38% have reached elementary grade and only 14.25% were able to attain high school level.

b. Women Sector




One attribution to the data on occupation could be in educational attainment of women in poor households. About 21.41% of women in poor housreholds were not able to finish or complete any grade level at all, and 17.96% are able to finish elementary grade as well as 16.48% were able to finish high school.

This shows that majority or 68,425 or 43.37% of the women in poor households were not able to complete either an elementary, high school or a college degree but was able to reach a certain level in either education level.

The sector of women among the poor households constituted the 157,760 or 48.21% of the total number of poor individuals within this province.

The women sector in the age range of 15 years old and above are mostly engaged as laborers and/or unskilled workers (13.14%) and service workers and shop and market sales workers (2%). Another data that is note worthy is the high magnitude of women in poor households declaring no occupation (80.87%)




c. Persons with Disability (PWD), Senior Citizens and Indigenous Peoples (IP) Group


There were 4,300 poor households with members who were found to have disability within this province. At an average, 614 households have a member who has any of the following disabilities e.g. hearing and visual impairment, speech defect, orthopedic, multiple disabilities, mentally challenged and other disability.⁸


The individual senior citizens of the poor households comprised the 10,170 or 3.11% of the total number of individuals within this province. Mostly they are found within the municipality of Angeles, Candaba and Lubao.





There are 1,930 poor households within this province who considered themselves as part of an indigenous people (IP) group. This constituted only a small part of the total poor households with only 3.49% percentage share. They were mostly found within the municipality of Porac, Florida Blanca and Angeles City.

3. Who and where the poor households are in terms of educational attainment






Majority or 62.47% of poor individuals of ages 3-18 years old within this province were attending school, they were mostly found within the municipality of Candaba, Angeles and Lubao. ⁹

The poor households put importance to education as evidenced by their attendance to school. Looking into age by level of schooling, 82.35% of of the poor individuals whose ages were within the interval 6-11 years were attending elementary, 49.14% of the poor individuals whose ages were within the interval 12-15 years were attending high school, and 10.37% of the poor individuals whose ages were within the interval 16-18 years were attending collegiate level. Notable is that 61.67% of the total poor households with school age children attends public school.

The highest educational attainment of poor individuals within this province were significant in the levels of no grade completed (21.83%) and elementary (18.60%). Majority of the poor households within this province had no grade completed. High concentration of these poor individuals can be found within the municipality of Angeles, Porac and Canbada.

4. Who and where the poor households are in terms of occupation?



The poor households source their income either as labourers to different menial jobs with 48,641 or 27.64%, through farming and fishing with 15,031 or 8.54% and service workers with 4,025 or 2.29%.

Quite notable is the number of members of the poor households declaring no occupation comprising to 56.89%, (given that the age range is 15 years old and above). ¹⁰

Majority of the members of poor households within this province who have declared no occupation were found within the municipality of Angeles, Candaba and Arayat.



5. Household Features of Poor Households

Out of the 55,328 poor households within this province, 7,433 or 13.43% have roof that were made up of light materials (cogon, nipa or bamboo). Same is true for the outer walls, 10,412 or 18.82% of the poor households have walls made up of light materials. Based on these data, 5,845 or 10.56% of the poor households within this province were considered to be vulnerable to natural/man-made disasters as they used light construction materials on the roofs and outer walls of their housing units. ¹¹






Figure 11 Figure 12



In terms of tenure status, out of the 55,328 poor households within this, 22,731 or 41% have their *Own House but Rented Free Lot with Consent of the Owner*. These poor households can be mostly found in the municipality of Angeles (61.27%), Candaba (44.06%) and Arayat (42.13%). ¹²

Furthermore, this situation is aggravated as poor households' minimal access to basic service facilities is also high (see Table B)

For water and sanitary toilet facilities, it can be noted that the magnitude of poor households within this province with safe water source is relatively high at 93.22% and that access to sanitary toilet is also fairly high with 60.50%. However, the number of poor households with no safe water source combined with unsanitary toilet practices¹⁵ is 2,397 or 4.33% of the total number of identified poor households.



Majority or 76.38% of the poor households within this province have access to electricity, whereas 23.62% of the poor households have no access to electricity. The areas with still no access to electricity based on the number of poor households identified were found in the municipality of Porac (39.19%), Angeles (28.22%) and Candaba (26.78%).




The top three programs/services that the poor households within the province of Nueva Ecija have received from different LGUs and NGOs were: Philhealth Cards with 18,337 or 33.84%, Subsidized Rice with 8,434 or 15.56% and Other services with 4,431 or 8.18%. However, it is quite alarming that 25,650 or 47.34% of the identified poor households within this province do not received any programs or services from the government, LGUs and NGOs. ¹⁶

Certain conveniences are also part of the features of the poor households. Assets such as Television, VCD/DVD, and Furniture, Stereo/CD Player, and Telephone/Cell phone are but a few of the poor households owned assets.¹⁷



It is quite interesting that the priority of our poor households is entertainment (see Figure 15).

As presented in this paper, this poverty profile of the NHTS-PR identified poor households is based on existing NHTS-PR data as of July 2011. This poverty profile did not only focus the beam on the poor, it also attempted to emphasize the relevance and importance of identifying who and where the poor are and understanding their conditions and characteristics.
