SUSPENSION OF WORK IN GOVERNMENT OFFICES ON

JULY 23, 2025 DUE TO CONTINUING RAINFALL

BROUGHT BY THE SOUTHWEST MONSOON

22 JULY 2025

Pursuant to Memorandum Circular No. 90 issued by the Office of the President, upon the recommendation of the National Risk Reduction and Management Council, work in government offices and classes at all levels in Metro Manila, Pangasinan, Zambales, Tarlac, Bataan, Pampanga, Bulacan, Cavite, Batangas, Rizal, Occidental Mindoro, Ilocos Norte, Ilocos Sur, La Union, Quezon, Oriental Mindoro, Marinduque, Romblon, Masbate, Sorosogon, Albay, Camarines Sur, Catanduanes, Palawan, Antique, Aklan, Capiz, Iloilo, Guimaras, Abra, Mountain Province, Ifugao, Benguet, Nueva Viscaya, Nueva Ecija, Laguna and Negros Occidental is **suspended on July 23, 2025**, due to continuous heavy rainfall brought about by the Southwest Monsoon.

However, in the exigency of service, offices involved in disaster response and the delivery of basic and health services and/or other vital services such as Disaster Response Management Division, Crisis Intervention Section providing Assistance to Individuals in Crisis Situation, as well as offices providing key support services such as the Administrative Division, Financial Management Division, Human Resource Management and Development Division, Information Communications Technology Management Section, and the Field Office III counterpart of the National Resource and Logistics Management Bureau and Strategic Communications Group, shall maintain a skeletal team to ensure continuity of operation.

All employees and Contract of Service / Job Order Workers of DSWD offices within Zambales, Bataan, Pampanga, Bulacan, Nueva Ecija and Tarlac who reported for work on the aforesaid date and will render overtime or extra services shall be compensated accordingly pursuant to existing guidelines.
